

# 2022 Environmental, Social, and Governance Highlights DRIVING PROGRESS

In 2022, we made meaningful strides toward building a more sustainable and resilient business, workplace, and industry. We continued to work toward our goal of achieving net zero Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 2050, and became the first fixed-base operator (FBO) worldwide to achieve carbon neutrality in our operations.

As the first FBO to offer a permanent supply of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) to business aviation, we expanded our physical SAF supply in 2022 and have pumped over 17 million gallons of SAF to date. We also made progress toward measuring our social and governance performance, setting ambitious objectives, and building our capacity to meet those objectives.

Looking ahead, sustainability will continue to inform our company strategy as we invest, innovate and collaborate with key external partners. We invite you to join us in shaping a more sustainable future for our industry.

In 2022, Signature became the first domestic and international FBO to achieve aggregate Tier 1 NATA sustainability certification.

### PRIORITIZED CYBERSECURITY

Made significant investments in processes, people, and technology to enhance our cyber maturity, including:

- Implemented continuous monitoring methodology resulting in a 60% decrease in vulnerabilities in our network
- Educated workforce on security best practices through **cybersecurity awareness training and anti-phishing campaigns**
- Implemented a Zero-Trust Model for existing FBOs and set target to implement the model for all new acquisitions
- Set target to formalize Governance, Risk, and Compliance and data loss prevention programs

#### DECARBONIZATION SPOTLIGHT: Achieving Carbon Neutrality at Signature's Eagle County, CO FBO

In December 2021, we announced the purchase of Vail Valley Jet Center (VVJC) FBO at the Eagle County Regional Airport (EGE) in Colorado. EGE was already committed to sustainability, with rooftop solar on Hangar 6, LED lighting, a fleet of electric tugs, as well as existing recycling protocols and other efficiencies on site. After the acquisition, we invested in various decarbonization efforts to achieve Carbon Neutral status in September 2022, including energy efficiency upgrades, utilization of B20 in all diesel-powered equipment, upgraded fleet to include electric and lower-emission ground-service equipment, purchased 100% renewable energy, and offset remaining Scope 1 emissions through purchase of verified local offsets.
